

Documents Necessary for Application Process

1. Birth certificates of the beneficiary and sponsor and any children.
2. Marriage certificates of the sponsor and beneficiary.
3. Any Divorce Decrees from prior marriages.
4. Death certificates of any former spouses.
5. Copy of passport and 1-94 (card stamped when you entered the US).
6. Two pictures (passport type) of sponsor.
7. Six pictures (passport type) of beneficiary.
8. Copies of any drivers' license, social security cards, or Alien Registration Cards of beneficiary and sponsor.
9. Copies of the last four years of tax filings for the sponsor.
10. Any financial documents (joint bank statements, joint loans, mortgage/rent papers, tax returns, etc.) or mortgage or rental agreements in both names to be taken to interview.
11. Any wedding pictures or family pictures.
12. Affidavits from 2 people who have knowledge of the marriage and know that it was not a sham marriage. These people may be called upon to testify at a later USCIS hearing.

NOTE: The documents indicated above are the basics. In many cases they are all that you will need to provide to our office. At other times, additional documents may be required. Having these documents available and organized will help us process your application faster.
